Pronoun		Nominative	Oblique	Possessive	Possessive	Reflexive
Binary	He	He is laughing	I called him	His eyes gleam	That is his	He likes himself
	She	She is laughing	I called her	Her eyes gleam	That is hers	She likes herself
Nonbinary	They (most common)	They are laughing	I called them	Their eyes gleam	That is theirs	They like <u>themselves</u>
	<u>Xe</u> "zee"	<u>Xe</u> is laughing	I called <u>xem</u>	<u>Xyr</u> eyes gleam	That is <u>xyrs</u>	<u>Xe</u> likes <u>xemself</u>
	<u>Ze</u> "zee"	<u>Ze</u> is laughing	I called <u>zir</u>	<u>Zir</u> eyes gleam	That is <u>zirs</u>	<u>Ze</u> likes <u>zirsself</u>
